

If you are an owner but a part-time resident, and you invite family or friends to occupy your home here, or if you have any tenants in your home, consider what would happen if a wildfire

would imminently threaten our community. <u>How would your guests know about the fire?</u> How would <u>you</u> know if you are off island? Are you signed up for our Call-Em-All emergency calling system? Is your <u>property manager</u> listed as a contact for the system? Even if you are signed up, would you have your phone on silent because of the time difference so you wouldn't hear the call? Would your property manager have their phone on silent in the middle of the night so they wouldn't get the call?

According to the Kohala by the Sea Community Rules and Regulations, Rule 13, section b:

Dwelling owners who do not live in the dwelling shall notify the association management company of the name and telephone number of occupants, tenants or guests who are residing in the dwelling so contact may be made in **emergency situations** or to obtain information needed to resolve an issue before the Board of Directors.

Please make a note to email the contact information for your guests to Dominic Yagong at Associa (<u>Dominic@associahawaii.com</u>) so that if you have consented to be signed up for the emergency calling system, he can add your guests' phone numbers to the list.

Then everyone will sleep better!
